4. Assessment Reporting (no updates)
 - a. 3-8 CBT – Operational Testing, NYSAA
 - i. Waiting on NYSED guidance RE: District Responsibility in the Questar and Kite admin platforms, if any.
 - b. NYSESLAT, Science 4&8, CTE
 - i. Waiting on guidance from NYSED.
 - c. NYSITEL
 - i. SCRIC will continue to process these as they are scanned by districts and will submit them to Level 1 on your behalf.
 - d. COSF
 - i. For the districts responsible for reporting Child Outcomes Summary Form, for Special Ed Indicator 7. Check with your CSE department. The COSF assessment file comes from your Spec Ed system (Cleartrack, IEP Direct)

- e. AP
 - i. Tests are offered online this year and how the results will be made available to districts is not clear. Unless there is guidance to the contrary, districts will be required to report the AP scores to SIRS via Level 0.
 - f. June Regents
 - i. SMS vendors are waiting for SED guidance to ready their systems for reporting Regents waivers.
5. Testing Exemptions – Identifying Students
- a. A survey will be sent to DDCs to determine district status on identifying students
 - b. One resource available is the SIRS-340 report. See the report guide here: <http://www.p12.nysed.gov/irs/level2reports/reportguides.html>
 - c. The info on the SIRS-340 report should be used in conjunction with the NYSED guidance on waivers found here: <http://www.nysed.gov/common/nysed/files/programs/coronavirus/nysed-covid-19-regents-grad-req-faq.pdf>
 - i. There is an unpublished clarification to FAQ #5:
 - ii. The language “or better his/her score” only applies to students who used a safety net, but intended to retake a Regents to earn a Regents diploma. Students who earned a 65 or above would not be eligible for the Regents exam exemptions.
 - d. The comprehensive website for NYSED guidance for P-12 Schools related to Covid-19 is here: <http://www.nysed.gov/coronavirus/guidance-p-12-schools>
 - e. **SCRIC WILL be collecting June 2020 Regent preprint data files!**
 - i. The intent is to create the necessary SIRS Exemption reporting files and load them to Level 1 on behalf of each district. Also to use the data to feed back to your SMS to do any necessary coding there, if possible.
 - ii. We are trying to be proactive and feel it is better to have this data and not need it than to need it and not have it!
 - iii. Email for each SMS about this collection will go out soon
 - iv. “Retaker” courses – only enter students who are entitled to the Exemption!
 - v. **Files will be due to the RIC June 5**
 - f. CTE
 - i. BOCES reports assessment and program service this year
 - ii. How do testing exemptions play into that?
 - g. Parent right to decline Regents Exemptions

 - ii. “Only those parents and persons in parental relation to students who are eligible to graduate as a result of an examination exemption are required to receive a notification”
6. SIRS Data – Day Calendar (no update)
- a. The end date for the school year will likely be earlier this year. Perhaps Mid June?
 - b. SCRIC recommendation is to do nothing until NYSED guidance comes out.
 - c. Whatever changes you make now will most likely have to change again after guidance comes out.

7. SIRS – EOY Report Certification

- b. Likely not all of these will be certified this year, but it's a good place to start. Compare counts to prior year, as a start.
