1. Review

- a. Any questions from previous meeting?

2. SMS Status Update

- a. Nothing new to report
- b. IF you know what your 2021 school opening plan is going to be, please contact your respective SMS support teams with the plan.

3. Assessment Reporting

- a. 3-8 CBT – Operational Testing, NYSAA
  - i. See the email from SIRSHELP dated 6/23 regarding NYSAA
  - ii. My opinion, not worth downloading the files from the DLM platform for NYSAA.
  - iii. Still no word on Questar and 3-8.
- b. NYSESLAT, Science 4&8, CTE
  - i. NYSESLAT, Science 4&8 - Nothing needs to be reported to SIRS
  - ii. CTE assessments given can be reported. CTE exemptions can also be reported
    - 1. BT BOCES is working on this
    - 2. ONC and DCMO status is unknown.
    - 3. Recall that approved CTE providers are to report Program Service and Assessment data for CTE this year.
- c. NYSITEL
  - i. SCRIC will continue to process these as they are scanned by districts and will submit them to Level 1 on your behalf.
- d. COSF

- i. For the districts responsible for reporting Child Outcomes Summary Form, for Special Ed Indicator 7. Check with your CSE department. The COSF assessment file comes from your Spec Ed system (Cleartrack, IEP Direct)
- e. AP
  - i. Districts still required to report these scores.

## f. June Regents

- i. NYSED released guidance: Regents exemptions will be reported with a standard achieved (Level) of 86 and an alpha score value of “E”.

## 4. Testing Exemptions

- a. SCRIC collected June 2020 Regents preprint data files.
  - i. SCRIC will only produce the exemption records necessary to report to SIRS.
  - ii. It is not possible at this time to create a file for importing to SMS to effect any “mass loading” of exemptions.
- b. CTE
  - i. BOCES reports assessment and program service this year, including exemptions.
- c. Parent right to decline Regents Exemptions
  - i. See the documents in the COVID-19 section of our web page:  
<https://www.southcentralric.org/DDCHome.aspx>
  - ii. “Only those parents and persons in parental relation to students who are eligible to graduate as a result of an examination exemption are required to receive a notification”
  - iii. Someone at each district should be in charge of a single list of declines. Be sure you know who it is and have access to the file. At some point, we will need to know who the declines are.

## 5. NYSESLAT Program Service Records

- a. Program Service code 0231 - NYSESLAT Eligible is typically ended when a student “tests out” on the NYSESLAT exam. However, the exam was cancelled this year. There are still students who may be eligible to have their 0231 record ended pursuant to NYSED Guidance:

- c. FAQ #9 “.....An exception to this requirement may be made for students who scored Expanding on the 2019 NYSESLAT and who took and passed the Regents Examination in English Language Arts in January 2020 with a score of 65 or higher. These students will be considered to have met the exit criteria for ELL services pursuant to Part 154.3(m)(1)(ii)....”
- d. Otherwise, students who are 0231 NYSESLAT eligible in 2020 should roll over and be eligible in 2021.
