1. SCRIC DW/Test Scoring and ALL DAS Staff
  - a. Some working at the office, some still remote...

2. 3-Year BEDS day Enrollment Summary
  - a. Updated as of 7/4
  - b. Note that non-resident students attending non pub schools data for that report comes from the non pub on their BEDS IMF, NOT SIRS.
3. Student Class Grade Detail
  - a. IS important to report because it impacts cohort driven ESSA accountability.
  - b. Extra weighting points are awarded based on taking and passing courses with certain state course codes.
4. Assessment Reporting (no updates)
  - a. 3-8 CBT – Operational Testing, NYSAA
    - i. Waiting on NYSED guidance RE: District Responsibility in the Questar and Kite admin platforms, if any.
  - b. NYSESLAT, Science 4&8
    - i. No assessment records are required to be reported.
  - c. NYSITEL
    - i. SCRIC will continue to process these as they are scanned by districts and will submit them to Level 1 on your behalf.
  - d. COSF
    - i. For the districts responsible for reporting Child Outcomes Summary Form, for Special Ed Indicator 7. Check with your CSE department. The COSF assessment file comes from your Spec Ed system (Cleartrack, IEP Direct)
  - e. AP, IB, SAT

# Teleconference Agenda



- i. Tests are offered online this year and how the results will be made available to districts is not clear. Unless there is guidance to the contrary, districts are supposed to report the AP scores to SIRS via Level 0, but only as it relates to
        - 1. ALTREG – Regents alternative testing
        - 2. CCR – college and career readiness
      - ii. ESSA accountability is cohort driven so collecting all data each year is important.
    - f. June Regents
      - i. SCRIC is creating the Regents exemptions. If you know of students no longer eligible for an exemption, email the details to SIRSHELP.
    - g. CTE
      - i. CTE assessments given can be reported. CTE exemptions can also be reported
      - ii. Each of the 3 BOCES is working on this
      - iii. 3. Recall that approved CTE providers are to report CTE Program Service and assessment data this year.
      - iv. SEQ – Assessment Sequence reporting in Arts and CTE
        - 1. See page 138 of the SIRS manual for discussion on CDOS, LOTE and SEQ assessment reporting.
        - 2. After discussing with NYSED, other RICS and our BOCES, the approved CTE program providers need not report CTE SEQ assessment data this year. The data are currently only reflected on the SIRS 340 and 341 graduation tracking reports and have no impact on accountability.
    - h. ALTRCT is no longer collected.
- 5. NYSESLAT Program Service Records
  - a. Program Service code 0231 - NYSESLAT Eligible is typically ended when a student “tests out” on the NYSESLAT exam. However, the exam was cancelled this year. There are still students who may be eligible to have their 0231 record ended pursuant to NYSED Guidance:

  - c. FAQ #9 “.....An exception to this requirement may be made for students who scored Expanding on the 2019 NYSESLAT and who took and passed the Regents Examination in English Language Arts in January 2020 with a score of 65 or higher. These students will be considered to have met the exit criteria for ELL services pursuant to Part 154.3(m)(1)(ii)....”
  - d. Otherwise, students who are 0231 NYSESLAT eligible in 2020 should roll over and be eligible in 2021.
- 6. SIRS Day Calendar and State Aid
  - a. State Aid office has yet to release updated guidance on SAMS attendance reporting.
- 7. SIRS – EOY Report Certification
  - a. See the EOY Reports and certification grid on our website: under Quick Reference Documents

- 8. Staff Evaluation Rating – Not collected this year.
