Discussion Items:

1. 2018-2019 student data reporting is closed.
 - a. Only Special Education Events and Staff Evaluation Rating can be entered in Level 0 for loading to Level 1 and 2.
2. 3-8 ELA, Math, NYSESLAT, NYSAA, Science Scores
 - a. As of August 20, all scores are in the SIRS-301 and 302 Tested-Not-Tested reports.
 - b. Be sure to use the NYSESLAT results to appropriately end the 0231 NYSESLAT eligible program service records. See page 49 of the SIRS manual for exit reason codes.
3. EOY Report Certification
 - a. EOY list of reports, on our Data page, under Quick Reference links here:

 - b. The EOY certification form in IDEX was wrong last Friday but has been corrected as of Monday morning.
 - c. The SIRS-108 College, Career and Civic Readiness report has a guide that explains how points are awarded for ESSA accountability based on student credential earned, participation in CTE programs, AP and IB tests taken, etc.
 - i. All SIRS report guides are available by clicking the link at the bottom of each report

 - iii. Data affecting the SIRS-108 cannot be changed at this point. See #1 above.
 - d. Special Ed PD Data Certification has been extended. See below from the site..

The 2018-19 SIRS refresh for the VR11-16 is still running. We have extended the due date for VR13, VR15 and VR16 to Wednesday August 28, 2019. We apologize for the delay.

Certification buttons are now disabled whenever a refresh is running to prevent inadvertent certifications of data while tables are being refreshed. Only the certifications that are required will appear on the dashboard.

- ii. If your PD reports are incorrect due to missing or incorrect student enrollment data, that can no longer be corrected. See #1 above.

4. Staff Evaluation Rating Data

- a. All teachers will have only one set of records: Either transition scores or original scores.
- b. Evaluation Rating data can only be loaded for staff that have a snapshot record.
 - i. Staff Snapshot records can no longer be added. See #1 above.
- c. SCRIC can provide spreadsheets for data entry upon your request

 - ii. There is A LOT of info but the Template Examples is good
 - iii. Each district has an AAPR summary available on their IRS Portal account.
 - iv. Anyone who is on the DATAG listserv saw this yesterday:
 - v. From EducatorEval:
 - vi. "State-provided growth scores will still be received by LEAs, but should not be used for staff evaluation.
 - vii. Due to the recent amendments to Education Law §3012-d, the NYS grades 3-8 ELA/math assessments (and therefore, State-provided growth scores) are excluded from staff evaluation – any educator whose original measures would be based on the 3-8 ELA/math assessments or SPG should receive transition scores and ratings based on the alternate SLO (and no original measures). Only those educators whose SLOs are not based on 3-8 ELA/math assessments or an SPG should receive original scores and ratings. State-provided growth scores will still be distributed to LEAs at some point in September."
 - viii. Bottom line is districts DO NOT need to wait on State Provided Growth scores in order to report ALL Staff Evaluation Rating Data
