3. Special Ed Certification Status

- a. NYSED status spreadsheet is attached to the SIRSHELP email announcing this agenda.

4. AP and IB Score Reporting

- a. Scores can still be reported in Level 0 and are due by October 8.
- b. Enter them manually in the Assessment Fact domain.
- c. The "test date" must be June 30 or prior, even if the score was awarded after June 30.

Upcoming Due Dates

September 1, 2020:

- Submit Forms SA-132 (Bonds & Refunding Bonds) and SA-135 (BANS) for capital project borrowings to SED.
- Submit the Underfunded High-Needs School Report for the 2019-20 NYS School Funding Transparency Form to SED. (Only for districts identified here: <http://www.oms.nysed.gov/faru/1920StateSchoolFundingTransparency.htm>).

September 2, 2020:

- Statutory due date for the 2020-21 State Aid Claim Forms (Forms A, FB, FT, and ST-3).

September 4, 2020:

- Statutory due date for the 2020-21 NYS School Funding Transparency Form.
- Submit Schedule F6: Bus Amortization through SAMS.
- Deadline for Requests for Transportation to Nonpublic and Charter Schools. See News Release here: <http://p12.nysed.gov/schoolbus/NewsNotes.htm>

6. For 2020-2021 school year:

- a. Instructor Delivery Method, on the Course/Instructor/Assignment record, is to be reported according to how the course was designed
- b. If the course was designed as face-to-face, that is how it should be reported, even if it is provided to the students via Zoom, skype, webex, Teams, etc.
- c. Computer Based Testing (CBT)
 - i. Each participating school MUST select at least one Simulation date when placing their order
 - ii. Simulations will be based on real student data this year. See the due dates below
- d. Day Calendar and Student / Staff Attendance, Enrollment
 - i. [See the document on our web page](#) or page 174 of SIRS manual

- e. **August Regents Exemptions**
 - i. All districts that had students who successfully recovered credit after June 30 AND who would have taken the August Regents, will need to report an August Regents Exemption.
 - ii. These will be entered into your student system (SMS) for transcripts, etc and may already have been entered.
 - iii. Districts will pull an Assessment Fact file from their SMS and load it to Level 0 (after L0 opens for school year 2021)

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Timeline and Due Dates

- **September 4** -- EOY SIRS reports certification due
 - District Superintendent will submit the certification of SIRS EOY reports via the IDEX system.

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- **Special Ed Reports**
 - **VR11, VR12, VR14 (Indicator 11 CSE and CPSE New Referrals, Indicator 12 Early Intervention New Referrals to CPSE, New Referrals from Non-Public (Parochial) Schools) .**
 - **Special Ed Events. Get the file from CSE and upload to L0**
 - **Every district must certify VR14, even if your count is zero**
 - **Certify Sept 21, data due in L0 Sept 17.**
 - **Note that Special Ed Events MUST have a student enrollment record already in Level 0 and student enrollment finished being collected in August.**
- **Late September -- Early to Mid December**
 - **Online 3-8 test ordering system opens**
- **October 8 -- Data due in Level 0 for August Graduates.**
- **October 8 - August Regents Exemptions (Assessment Fact) (to the extent possible...these can still be reported until the end of the year)**
- **October 8 – AP and IB scores (Assessment Fact)**
- **October 22 -- Student data due in Level 0 for CBT Simulation Day 1**
 - **Simulation Day 1 expected to be early December**
- **December 10 -- Student data due in Level 0 for CBT Simulation Day 2**
 - **Simulation Day 2 expected to be early to mid January**
