
Discussion Items:

1. Level 0
 - a. SUNY Children's Unit Treatment and Evaluation – Location code Table
 - i. NYSED has changed the BEDS code
 - ii. Districts are being notified how to proceed with creating a new location and making the old one invalid.
 - iii. In the meantime, if you have errors related to those locations, you can delete the student records in Level 0 so you can lock.
2. August 2019 Graduates
 - a. Data due in Level 0 **October 10**
 - b. Demographic, Enrollment with ending reason codes, diploma types & post grad activity
3. Staff Evaluation Rating Data - Data is due in Level 0 by **OCTOBER 17**
 - a. All teachers will have only one set of records: Either transition scores or original scores. Which depends on your district's APPR plan.
 - i. Email educatoreval@nysed.gov if you have questions.
 - b. Evaluation Rating data can only be loaded for staff that have a snapshot record.
 - i. The window for adding staff snapshot records for the 18-19 year closed in August.
 - c. SCRIC can provide spreadsheets for data entry upon your request
